

Zero tolerance against sexual and gender-based harassment



General Decalogue

- 1. Behave respectfully towards all staff and demand the same respect for oneself. Do not encourage intimidating, demeaning or offensive environments for others.
- 2. Respect plurality. Do not make remarks, gestures, mockery or jokes about the appearance of others, or about their sexual orientation. Do not use nicknames.
- 3. Avoid jokes or comments of a sexual nature that may be offensive to others.
- 4. Avoid obscene jokes or comments that violate human dignity.
- 5. Do not make sexual requests or advances without consent. Consent is only given when it has been freely given by acts that clearly express the person's will.
- 6. Avoid deliberate and unwanted physical contact and excessive and unnecessary

- physical nearness. Respect the personal space of others. Always ask to avoid an uncomfortable situation.
- 7. Let us contribute to making workplaces a diverse, safe and inclusive space for all people, regardless of their sexual orientation and identity.
- 8. Do not show or distribute personal images or videos without due consent.
- 9. Do not force others to participate in unwanted recreational activities or deliberately seek to be alone with someone without wilful consent.
- 10. Do not participate in group dynamics of harassment towards another person that seek social isolation and avoid spreading rumours of any kind that may be offensive, create discomfort or generate rejection.
